Interpreting Your CRC Student/Graduate Outcome Data Report

Interpreting Your CRC Student and or Graduate Outcome Data Report Student and Graduate outcomes are reported separately. CRCC only report exam results for programs where there are 5 or more students and/or 5 or more graduates that sat for the exam during the reported exam cycles. This policy protects the anonymity of students and graduates and aligns with CRCC's accreditation policy.

CRCC only report results on students and graduates who are unique (*first time*) test takers enrolled in or recently (2018) graduated from your program.

Students: Are defined as students enrolled in your program at the time they sat for the exam.

Graduates: Are defined as individuals who completed your program in 2018 to present.

Unique: First-time test takers

Exam Cycles: The range of examination dates.

Number Sitting: The number of unique test takers who were students enrolled in your graduate program **or** who

had completed your program at the time they sat for the exam.

Number Passing: The number of unique test takers who passed the exam and were students enrolled in your

graduate program or who had completed your program at the time they sat for the exam.

University Pass Rate: The percentage of people from your institution who passed the exam.

Student/Graduate

Overall Pass Rate: The percentage of all unique test takers who passed the exam.

Knowledge Domains: The twelve knowledge domains derived from the Role and Function Study are the foundation of

the CRC exam. A Role and Function Study is the process providing the empirical data that are

used to update and validate the CRC Exam specifications every 5 years.

Average National

Score: The average national score incorporates data from both accredited and non-accredited

programs. This information is presented under the Counseling and Rehabilitation/Disability

Section headings.

University Average

Score: The university average student or graduate score shows the average score for your students or

graduates. This information is presented under the Counseling and Rehabilitation/Disability

Section headings.

When interpreting your reports:

- 1.) The aggregate data are broken down by Counseling and Rehabilitation/Disability and include the associated knowledge domains.
- 2.) If a knowledge domain is specific to either the Counseling or the Rehabilitation/Disability section, the averages for the other section of the table will be greyed out.
- 3.) Please refer to the CRC exam knowledge domains located in section 11 of the <u>CRC Certification Guide</u> for additional context when interpreting scores.
- 4.) This report represents the scores unique (first-time) test takers. If an applicant has taken the exam multiple times, subsequent attempts were not added in any of the statistical analysis provided in these reports.
