We asked people to share what they did to prepare for the CRC Exam. Here's the advice they are sharing with you.

Study tips

- Don't procrastinate. I made a plan for studying and stuck to it.
- I studied in intervals so I didn't get overloaded.
- I studied with buddies. We created flash cards and tested one another. We explained our answers to each other.
- I took the CRC Interactive Practice Test and focused my studies on the topics I got wrong.
- I prepared a little each week for a couple of months before I took the exam.
- The questions on the exam are multiple choice. Just remember that the correct answer will be one of the options.
- If you are finishing your graduate program, take the exam as soon as you can while everything is fresh in your mind.
- Don't always study in the same location. You remember more information if you vary when and where you study.

Before the exam

- Get a good night's sleep. Tell yourself, "I've got this!"
- Don't cram the day of the exam.
- Eat healthy and get some exercise to help relieve stress.
- The night before the exam, don't study. Relax.
- Don't doubt yourself. You've worked hard to reach this goal.
- Check the exam vendor's website and make sure you have everything you'll need to take with you.
- Drink plenty of water. Your brain works best when it is hydrated.

During the exam

- Focus and concentrate on the exam. It's the most important thing that day.
- Take your time, block out the rest of the room, and read each question carefully.
- Use the process of elimination to get rid of answers that don't make sense. Trust your instincts.
- I took the whole time available to me.
